

## RAISING RILEY SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFYING FACTORS

**1. Income qualifies family for free or reduced lunch – 185% of poverty**

**INCOME SOURCES THAT MUST BE COUNTED WHEN**

**DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDCARE TUITION ASSISTANCE:**

Gross earned wages

Documentation of financial assistance from other countries

Adjusted gross income from taxable self-employment income

Social Security Benefits

Workers' compensation

Disability compensation

Unemployment benefits

Alimony/maintenance

Child support, direct or indirect

Armed Forces pay (will include base pay, BAH, allotments, and hazardous duty pay)

**INCOME SOURCES NOT COUNTED WHEN DETERMINING**

**ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDCARE TUITION ASSISTANCE:**

Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

Educational program loans, grants, and scholarships

**2. Custodial parent is unmarried, not living with other biological parent, and income is below 225% of poverty**

**3. Teen parent at time of child's birth**

**4. Child lacking health care insurance**

**5. Either parent has less than a high school education**

**6. First language not English, or English is not primarily spoken in the home**

**7. Child is in foster care or court ordered custodial/kinship care**

**8. DCF referral**

**9. Child at-risk for developmental delays or has established IFSP/IEP**

**10. Child w/inadequate housing/chronic or episodic homelessness**

**11. Migrant status**
