Teen parent at time of child's birth
 Custodial parent is unmarried
 Child lacking health care insurance
 Either parent has less than a high school education
 First language is not English or English is not primarily spoken in the home
 Child is in foster care or court ordered custodial/kinship care
 DCF referral
 Child at-risk for developmental delays or has established IFSP / IEP
 Children w/inadequate housing/chronic or episodic homelessness
 Migrant status

Eligible Income Sources

The following are sources of income that must be counted when determining eligibility for child care services:

Gross earned wages
 Documentation of financial assistance from other countries
 Adjusted gross income from taxable self-employment income
 Social Security Benefits
 Workers' compensation
 Disability compensation
 Unemployment insurance benefits (UIB)
 Alimony/maintenance
 Child support, direct or indirect
 Armed Forces pay (will include base pay, BAH, allotments, and hazardous duty pay)

The following are sources of income which are not counted when determining eligibility for child care services:

Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 Educational program loans, grants and scholarships
