- Teen parent at time of child's birth
- Custodial parent is unmarried
- Child lacking health care insurance
- Either parent has less than a high school education
- First language is not English, or English is not primarily spoken in the home
- Child is in foster care or court ordered custodial/kinship care
- DCF referral
- Child at-risk for developmental delays or has established IFSP/IEP
- Children w/inadequate housing/chronic or episodic homelessness
- Migrant status

Eligible Income Sources

The following are sources of income that must be counted when determining eligibility for child care services:

- Gross earned wages
- Documentation of financial assistance from other countries
- Adjusted gross income from taxable self-employment income
- Social Security Benefits
- Workers' compensation
- Disability compensation
- Unemployment insurance benefits (UIB)
- Alimony/maintenance
- Child support, direct or indirect
- Armed Forces pay (will include base pay, BAH, allotments, and hazardous duty pay)

The following are sources of income which are not counted when determining eligibility for child care services:

- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Educational program loans, grants and scholarships
